

Lawrence Kansas Friday January 10th 1879

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Those were present. Commissioners John Deskinies Chairman John Walton and J. C. Walton and County Clerk B. F. Diggs
In the matter of the Petition of }
N. R. Anderson and others }
for a Change of Road }

The report of the viewers appointed at the last October Session of the Board on the petition of N. R. Anderson and others for a change in a State road, was taken up by the Board. The report was publicly read, and considered by the Board. There being no claims for damages on account of the change in the road, and no legal objection being made. And the Board being satisfied that such change would be a public benefit. It was ordered by the Board that said road be changed according to the prayer of the petitioners by vacating and relocating as recommended by the viewers, and the field note and survey of the Surveyor attached to said viewers report, and the Clerk was instructed to record the Report of the Viewers and Surveyor in the Road Records of the County, and issue the necessary orders for the opening of the same.
In the matter of Petition of }
W. S. Pennington for Road }

The report of the viewers for Road petitioned for by W. S. Pennington and others which was laid over from the last October session of the Board was taken up and considered by the board.

The board being of the opinion, that that portion of the Road petitioned for, Beginning at the S. W. Cor. of Sec. 26, Township 12 S. of Range 17 E. and running thence North $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the 14 sec. Cor. between Secs. 22 and 23 of said Township and Range, would not be of sufficient public utility to justify the payment of the amount of damages claimed by the owners of the land along that portion of the road that part of the petition and report of the viewers thereon was rejected.

There being no claims for damages along the balance of the line of road petitioned for, and the Commissioners being of the opinion that that portion of the road would be of sufficient public utility to justify them in locating the road It was Ordered: that that portion of the road beginning at the 14 sec. Cor. between Sections 22 and 23 of Township 12 S. of Range 17 East, and running thence
