The Board made an appropriation of one hundred dollars to pay W. W. Kevison for legal services in the Mandamus suits against the County Commissioners in the U. S. Courts.

The Board made an appropriation of two hundred and fifty dollars to pay Messrs. Riggs and Kevison for legal services in the U. S. Court, in the Mandamus suits against the Board of County Commissioners
