The motion was declared carried, and the Clerk was instructed to issue a license to said Bridge Company for six months.

J. C. Walton moved that the rates of toll under the license be established at the same rates that have been charged for the past year on the Bridge, and on the rate being taken, the motion was declared carried. John Walton and J. C. Walton voting "Aye" and John Deskins "No"
