Safe for County Treasury*

The Board took up the matter of purchasing a safe, and having the same under consideration entered into contract with Mr Parsons, agent for Healls Safe Company, for a Burglar proof safe with time lock attachment, at a price of Eight hundred and ninety dollars (\$890⁰⁰) delivered at the Depot at Lawrence. \$200⁰⁰ to be paid on delivery of the safe, the balance to be paid December 1st 1879.

The freight to be paid by the County and deducted from the December payment.

*In the matter
of Bridges*

Mr Farnsworth agent for the Mo. Valley Bridge Company appeared before the Board and made a proposition to build certain bridges contemplated by the County, but without taking any action thereon, the matter was laid over for further consideration.

The Bill of B. F. Diggs for sundries paid for by him amounting to \$35.10 was considered by the Board and allowed.
