Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment.

In the matter of Advertising {

The Contract with H. A. Cutler for doing
the job printing and blanks for the County, was extended for one
year at the same rates as during the past year.

T. D. Thachers proposition to do the advertising for the County
for the next year was accepted as follows

To do all the advertising for the County at legal rates and
all advertising except the Delinquent Tax list and Redemption
list to have published in the "Kansas Tribune" and "The
Standard"

In the matter of Redemption {
of Lot 228 Ohio Street Lawrence } 3

L.D.L. Tash presented a petition to the Board
asking that H. M. Hammond be allowed to redeem lot 228
Ohio Street in the City of Lawrence from the tax sales of 1862 and
1863 at ten per cent interest.

On Motion it was ordered that the said H. M. Hammond
be allowed to redeem lot 228 Ohio Street in the City of
Lawrence from the tax sale of 1862 for the tax of 1861 and from the
Sale of 1863 for the tax of 1862 upon the payment of the amounts
for which said lot was sold with interest on the same
at the rate of ten per cent per annum.

In the matter of Redemption
of lot 71 New Jersey St.

On motion it was ordered by the Board
that Mary C. Chadwick be allowed to redeem lot 71
New Jersey Street in the City of Lawrence from the tax
sale of 1864 for the tax of 1865 upon the payment by her of
the amount for which said lot was sold, \$10⁴⁶ and
Cost of Redemption, without interest
