

Manley and others asking for a change in a County road was presented to the Board as follows:

To the Honorable County Commissioners of Douglas County  
Kansas.

We the undersigned resident householders of Marion Township, Douglas County Kansas, respectfully petition to have the following part of a road vacated, as follows, to wit: Beginning about Eighty (80) rods South from the North West corner of the South West quarter of Section No. 13, Township Fourteen (14) Range Seventeen (17) thence South on said line to South West corner of the North West quarter of Section No. (24) twenty four Township Fourteen (14) Range Seventeen (17) thence East half a mile on the South line of said quarter section, and locate beginning about Eighty (80) rods South from the North West corner of the South West quarter of Section No. Thirteen (13) Township Fourteen (14), Range Seventeen (17) thence angling through said quarter so as to strike the East and West road about fifty six (56) rods from the South West corner of said quarter thence East on said road about Eighty (80) rods, thence South through the North West quarter of Section No. Twenty four (24) angling so as to strike the S. E. corner of said quarter.

And your petitioners respectfully ask that if said road is not vacated and located as prayed for, then they ask for an appropriation of one hundred dollars for to make the old road passable.

The petition being signed by at least twelve resident householders, and being accompanied by a bond as required by law, the Board appointed Stuart H. Enslow, John C. Metzker and Thomas Price as viewer to meet with the County Surveyor to view and survey said road according to law, and the Clerk was instructed to issue the necessary notices required by law.
