

that a change be made in a road running through the center of Section 22 Town 13 Range 19 Douglas County, Kansas commencing near the center of said section and running in northerly direction around a bluff and coming on $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. line about 90 rods South of the N.E. corner of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section twenty two (22) Town twelve (12) Range nineteen (19) Douglas County, Kansas, and vacating the part that lies on the line between those points above described.

The petition being signed by at least 12 resident householders, and being accompanied by a bond as required by law, the Board appointed Jordan Keil, J. J. McFee and John McFarland as viewers to meet with the County Surveyor to view and survey said road according to law.

The Clerk was directed to issue the necessary notices as required by law.

A Petition signed by Charles Pilla and others asking for a change and relocation of a County road was presented to the Board as follows

The undersigned hereby respectfully petition your honorable Board to vacate a certain road described herein and relocate the same as also described below to wit:

To Vacate, beginning at a point at the N.W. corner of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, T. 13 R. 21 thence running North 80 rods to section line thence East 80 rods along said section line to line of City of Eudora thence South about 150 ft to point where it intersects Street in City of Eudora

Relocate said road as follows.

Beginning at the North West corner of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, T. 13 R. 21 thence run East 80 rods to Townsite of City of Eudora -

The petition being signed by at least twelve resident householders and being accompanied by a bond as required by law, the Board appointed Thomas McFarland, John Garvin and Nathan Henshaw as viewers to meet with the County Surveyor to view and survey said road as provided by law, and the Clerk was instructed issue the necessary notices as required by law
