Beginning at the point where said road strikes the East line of the North East quarter of Section one Town fourteen Range Seventeen, thence South Sixty five rods more or less to the South East corner of said quarter section, thence West on the South line of said quarter Eighty two rods more or less to where it will again intersect the said Lawrence and Emporia State road.

In the Matter of Petition
of Geo. W. Knight and
others for relocation of a Road

A petition signed by George W. Knight and others asking for the relocation of a County road was presented to the Board as follows.

To the Hon Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kans.
Gentlemen, Your petitioners, Residents and householders of Douglas County, Kansas and residing within the vicinity of the road petitioned for, respectfully petition your Honors to relocate a public road commencing at the County line between Secs 13 and 18 and running North between Sections 13 and 18 and between Sections 12 and 7 to the quarter corner between said sections 12 and 7 one and one half miles all in Township 15 Range 17 and 18.

The petition being signed by at least 12 resident householders and being accompanied by a bond as required by law, the Board appointed John Bankers, George Smith and J. R. Barton as viewers to meet with the County Surveyor to view and survey said road according to law, and the Clerk was instructed to issue the necessary notices as required by law.
