The Board resumed consideration of the several bids for the construction of Iron bridges for the County, and the contract for building an Iron Bridge across the Wakarusa river at the "Hutchinson Crossing" was awarded to the "Missouri Valley Bridge and Iron Works" for the sum of Two thousand nine hundred and ninety-seven (\$2997.⁰⁰) dollars

The contract for building an Iron Bridge across the Wakarusa River at "Sigel" was awarded to Messrs. Raymond and Campbell of Council Bluffs, Iowa, for the sum of Two thousand nine hundred and seventy six and ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ (\$2976.⁵⁰) dollars.

The contract for building an Iron Bridge ~~over~~ across the Wakarusa river at "Eudora" was awarded to the "Columbia Bridge Works" of Dayton Ohio, J. H. and C. C. Morrison, Agents, for the sum of Two thousand eight hundred and five and ⁶⁴/₁₀₀ (\$2805.⁶⁴) dollars

The contract for building an Iron Bridge across Mud Creek at "Robinsons Crossing" was awarded to the said Columbia Bridge Works for the sum of Eleven hundred and thirty one and ¹⁹/₁₀₀ (\$1131.¹⁹) dollars.

Board adjourned until next Wednesday May 21st at 9 o'clock A.M.
