

Lawrence, Kansas Friday June 27th 1879

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to law at the office of the County Clerk, for the purpose of canvassing the vote cast at the special Election held in Douglas County, and also in Clinton and Eudora Townships on the 24th inst.

Those were present Commissioners John Deskinies Chairman John Walton and J. C. Walton and Deputy County Clerk Albert Brooks

The Board proceeded to open and canvass the returns from the several voting precincts and declared the result to be as follows. To wit:

Seventeen hundred and eight (1708) votes for the proposition authorizing the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Kansas to compromise the Bonded indebtedness of the County at fifty cents on the dollar, and Ninety six (96) votes against said proposition, and so declared the proposition carried.

The Board also declared the result of the Election in Clinton Township to be as follows. viz:

One hundred and sixteen (116) votes for the proposition to compromise the Bonded indebtedness of Clinton Township at fifty cents on the dollar, and seven (7) votes against said proposition, and so declared the proposition carried.

The Board also declared the result of the Election in Eudora Township to be as follows. viz: One hundred and seventy eight (178) votes for the proposition to compromise the bonded indebtedness of the County at fifty cents on the dollar, and two (2) votes against said proposition, and so the proposition was declared carried.
