Board of County Commissioners met in Special Session
Called by the Chairman at the request of Commissioners
John and J. C. Walton, at the office of the County Clerk
There were present Commissioners John Deskins
Chairman, John Walton and J. C. Walton and Deputy County Clerk A. B.
Brooks

In the Matter of offer }

to purchase Bonds }

The Board having under consideration
the offer of Thomas H. Larkin and Cal. Moore of St. Louis
to compromise \$6000.00 of bonds held by them at the rate
of 50 cents on the dollar for bonds and accrued interest
and take new bonds of the County.

on motion the offer was accepted and the Clerk
was instructed to notify Mr Larkin of the action of
the Board, and inform him that new bonds would
be issued as soon as the necessary blanks could
be prepared.

The Clerk was also instructed to notify Mr Larkin
that the Board would give him fifty cents on the
dollar in new bonds for a certain judgement
held by him against the County and referred to by
him in a letter of February 5th 1879.

It appearing that many papers
that should be on file in the office of the County
Clerk, can not be found, and the Board having reason
to believe that they have been filed in said office, but have
been taken therefrom by parties not authorized to
have such papers in charge, and have not been
returned. It was ordered. that the County Clerk
allow no books or papers on file in his office as
part of the records of said office to be taken therefrom
without an order from some court having authority
or unless accompanied by himself or Deputy.
The Clerk was further ordered to notify the
County Treasurer and Register of Deeds to allow none
of the Books or papers in their offices as part of
the records thereof to be taken from their offices
by any person not authorized by law to do so
