Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk

The Reports of Viewers on the petitions of Geo. H. Knight and others, D. H. Manley and others, and Jacob Badsby and others, were taken up and laid over until the October Session of the Board.

In the matter of the Petition }
of Chas Pilla and others for a Road }

A report signed by one of the viewers appointed at the April Session of the Board ~~was from~~ on the petition of Chas Pilla and others for a change in a road, was presented to the Board.

The Board being of the opinion that the location of road on the report of only one of the viewers, would be illegal and of no effect. On motion it was ordered, that the Co. Clerk be instructed to issue new notices to the viewers and Surveyor and make due publication of the time of viewing the road, according to law and have the road viewed and surveyed as provided by law.

G. W. E. Griffith and Jacob House were appointed by the Board to assist the Probate Judge in counting the funds in the County Treasury during the coming quarter.

In the matter of the Petition }
of Patrick Donoughly and others }
for a County Road }

A petition signed by Patrick Donoughly and others asking that a County road be located and established along the following described line, was presented to the Board. Commencing at the N.W. corner of Section fifteen (15) Township fifteen (15) Range Twenty (20) also at a public Road running North and South and thence running East on the Douglas and Franklin County line a distance of Seven (7) miles to the East line of Douglas County.

The petition being signed by 12 resident householders and being accompanied by a bond as required by law. the Board appointed Oliver Johnson, J. T. Starr and W. J. Meador as viewers to meet with the County Surveyor to view and survey said road according to law. The Co.
