of Jacob Yeager and others
for a change in a road.

A petition signed by Jacob Yeager and others asking that a change be made in a certain road, described as follows, was presented to the Board.

Your Petitioners Householders of Leexemption Township, Douglas County, would petition your honorable body to cause to be viewed and altered a portion of the road running from Leexemption to Big Springs as follows, viz: to vacate that portion of said road beginning on said road about 80 rods West from the West line of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 6, 12, 18, and running diagonally S.W. across the N.W. 1/4 Sec 6, 12, 18 about 80 rods in length and then view and locate in place of the vacated portion a road commencing on the road about 80 rods from West line of N.E. 1/4 Sec 6, 12, 18 on said road and running Westwardly until it strikes the East line of N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 1, 12, 17 thence due South until it strikes the road as now laid out, the road to be vacated and the one to be laid out are both wholly on the land of Jacob Yeager who petitions for this change.

The petition being signed by twelve resident householders and being accompanied by a bond as required by law the Board appointed William Nace, W. H. Christian and A. H. Buck as viewers to meet with the County Surveyor and view and survey said road according to law.

of John Staib and others
for a County Road

A petition signed by John Staib and others was presented to the Board asking that a County road be located and established along the following described line.

Commencing at the corner to sections 28, 29, 32 and 33 of Township 1st South of Range 21 East. thence running South on the section line between sections 32 and 33 of Township 1st. and sections 4 and 5, 8 and 9 of Township 15. all in Range 21 to the South line of Douglas County.

The petition being signed by 12 resident house-
