The Board having received a proposition from A. East & Co. of St. Louis to furnish the County with one thousand blank lithographed bonds of three different denominations for the sum of \$163.⁵⁰ on motion it was ordered that the County Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to procure of said A. East & Co. one thousand bonds of twenty series lettered from "A" to "T" fifty bonds of each series of the following denominations and numbers viz:
fifteen Bonds of \$1000 each numbered from 1 to 15
fifteen Bonds of 500 each numbered from 16 to 30 and
Twenty Bonds of 100 each numbered from 31 to 50
Series A. to become due and payable July 1st 1889
Series B. July 1st 1890 and so on to Series T. to become due and payable July 1st 1909.

The bonds to be best Lithograph work and best paper.

The Board had under Consideration the refunding of the Rail Road bonded indebtedness of the County. The following resolution was introduced and on motion adopted -

Resolved - On the 27th day of February 1879 The Legislature of the
