

of the State of Kansas, passed an act Entitled an Act to Authorise and empower the County of Douglas to take up and refund its Rail Road Bonded indebtedness - which said act Authorised and empowered the Board of County Commissioners of said County to take up and refund any of its outstanding bonds and Coupons or any judgments thereon at the rate of fifty cents on the dollar, by issuing new bonds of the County therefor when authorized by a majority of the legal voters of said County at some general or special election to be held for that purpose as provided for in said act.

And whereas at a special Election duly called by the Board of County Commissioners of said County for that purpose and duly held on the 24th day of June A.D. 1879, a Majority of the legal voters of said County of Douglas Authorized and instructed its Board of County Commissioners to Compromise its outstanding R.R. bonded indebtedness and the Coupons due thereon and the judgments obtained thereon according to the provisions of the act above referred to Now therefore be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County on this 31st day of July A.D. 1879, that we do proceed to Compromise the Rail Road Bonded indebtedness of said Douglas County and the Coupons due thereon and the judgments obtained thereon by issuing the bonds of said County known and designated in said act as "Series" bonds at the rate of fifty cents on the dollar for all such indebtedness on the first day of July A.D. 1879
