In the matter of
Tax Levy for 1878

The motion to levy tax as made at yesterday's
meeting was taken up for consideration, and a vote
being taken it was carried unanimously and the levy
declared made as follows.

For General Revenue of the County Seven and one half (7 1/2)
mills on the dollar of all the taxable property in the County.
For Bridges two (2) mills on the dollar of all the taxable
property in the County.

For interest Compromise bonds Six (6) mills on the
dollar of all the taxable property in the County.

The several Township Trustees having made recommenda-
tion for a of tax for Township purposes as follows

Wakarusa Township for general revenue one and one half (1 1/2) mills
Lecompton Township for general revenue one (1) mill
Kannaka Township for general revenue two (2) mills
Clinton Township for general revenue two (2) mills
