Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk

There were present Commissioners John Deskinies Chairman John Walton and J. C. Walton and Deputy County Clerk Albert H. Brooks

The Board had under consideration the Rail Road bonded indebtedness of the County.

The following resolution was introduced, considered and passed by a unanimous vote of the Board.

Resolved That such bond holders as have offered to compromise at the rate of fifty per cent of the bonds Coupons past due and interest on the same, be notified that their offer is accepted, on condition a satisfactory settlement can be made with the attorneys in the Moses Taylor suit, and as soon as such settlement shall be had, bonds will be issued as the old bonds shall be presented, and the class of bonds desired, specified
