

Lawrence Kansas Saturday August 30th 1879

Board of County Commissioners met in special session at the office of the County Clerk, on the call of the Chairman.

Those were present Commissioners John Deskinies Chairman, John Walton and J. C. Walton and Deputy County Clerk Albert H. Brooks
 For the matters Compromising }
 Rail Road bonds held by Messrs }
 Nelson and Noel of St. Louis Mo }

Mrs. S. W. E. Griffith sent in to the Board 36 bonds of \$1000. each which he had received from Messrs Nelson and Noel of St. Louis Mo. and asked that new bonds be issued to them according to agreement between the Board of Commissioners and said Nelson and Noel. Twenty nine of said bonds had attached ten or part due Coupons of \$35.⁰⁰ each numbered from 11 to 20 inclusive No. 11 being payable January 1st 1875 and each succeeding No. Six month later the last one No. 20 being due July 1st 1879, and seven of the said bonds having Six (6) part due Coupons attached of \$35.⁰⁰ each and numbered from 15 to 20 inclusive. No. 15 being payable January 1st 1877 and each succeeding No. Six months later the last, No. 20 being payable July 1st 1879. the total amount of Matured Coupons being \$8540.⁰⁰ and the interest on the same from maturity to July 1st 1879 being \$918.⁷⁵ Making a total of \$45,458.⁷⁵ and the Board of Commissioners delivered to said S. W. E. Griffith in lieu thereof new Six percent bonds to the amount of \$22,700.⁰⁰ and the old bonds and Coupons were registered and Cancelled according to law. The balance of \$29,758.⁷⁵ over and above the amount of the new bonds to be settled at some future time

The Board received notices from the Contractors for the Bridges across the Wakarusa River at Sigel and Hutchinsons Crossing. that the bridges would be completed on Monday September 1st. And on motion of J. C. Walton the Chairman Dr. Deskinies, and John Walton were appointed a Committee to go with the County Surveyor, on Tuesday September 2nd and inspect said bridges and report if the Bridges are built according to Contract plans and Specifications
