

Lawrence Kansas Thursday September 18th 1879

Board of County Commissioners met in special session at the office of the County Clerk on the call of the Chairman. There were present Commissioners John Deskinies Chairman, John Walton and J. C. Walton, and Deputy County Clerk Albert H. Brooks.

In the matter of Taxes
on the St. L. & W. R. R.

A proposition was received from John J. P. Wether in regard to the delinquent taxes on the St. L. & W. R. R. and offered to pay \$250.00 for an assignment of the Tax sale Certificate of the sale of 1875 for the taxes on said road for the year 1874.

The Board having the same under consideration and after considerable passed the following Resolution.

Whereas the above J. P. Wether has made a proposition to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County in regard to the adjustment of the taxes now due from the St. L. & W. R. R. Co. Now therefore be it Resolved that the said Company shall be allowed to redeem said Road from the sale of the year 1875 for the taxes of the year 1874 for the sum of \$250.00 provided said road is put in good running order forthwith and shall be operated for the term of five years. And that the County Attorney of Douglas County be instructed and directed to bring suit in the District Court of Douglas County against said Company for the taxes due from said Company for the years 1875, 1876, 1877 and 1878 and put the same into a judgment.

The vote on the foregoing Resolution being as follows for the passage of the resolution. Commissioners John Deskinies and J. C. Walton, against the resolution Commissioner John Walton.
