Board of County Commissioners met in special Session at the office of the County Clerk, on the call of the Chairman,

Those were present Commissioners John Derkines Chairman John Walton and J. C. Walton and Deputy County Clerk Albert H. Brooks

In the matter of Taxes on the
St. L. & N. R. R. Road }

The Board had under consideration the agreement made with the Hon J. P. Visher on the 18th inst in regard to the Redemption of the Taxes on the St. L. & N. R. R. from the sale of 1875 for the taxes of the year 1874 on condition that the said road be put in good running order forthwith, and passed the following Resolution.

Whereas, on the 18th day of September 1879 a Resolution was passed by this Board authorizing the Hon J. P. Visher to redeem the St. L. & N. R. R. from the sale of 1875 for the taxes of the year 1874 for the sum of \$250.00 provided the said road was put in good running order forthwith, and should be operated for the term of five years, and whereas the said J. P. Visher has failed to comply with the provisions specified in said Resolution.

Now therefore Resolved - that the said Resolution be and the same is hereby rescinded.

The resolution was adopted by the following vote.
