P. T. Rhodes agent for the Kansas
 Educational Association of the M. E. Church having made
 a statement that lots 106, 108, 112, 114 and 116 Baker Street
 and lot 96 Chapel Street, lot 76 Grove Street lot 154 High
 Street lots 137, 139, 141, 143, 145, 150, 152 and 154 Jersey Street
 and lots 45, 51, 53, 55, and 114 Kearton Street and Lot 105
 Indiana Street all in Baldwin City, had been sold for
 taxes, that at the time said taxes were levied the property
 belonged to the said Kansas Educational Association of
 the M. E. Church and were not subject to taxation under
 the law, and asked that said taxes be cancelled on the
 sale records of the County. On Motion it was ordered,
 by the Board, that upon the said P. T. Rhodes making
 affidavit that the said property was owned by the said
 Association at the time the taxes were levied, that the
 County Clerk be instructed to cancel the said taxes on
 the sale records of the County.
