H. T. Davis having filed a petition asking
the Board to grant him the privilege of leaving a hedge
now standing on the West line of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 27, T. 12
R. 19 it being in the center of an established road
until the said Davis should have time to grow another
hedge on the line of said road, the petition was rejected
as the Commissioners decided they had no jurisdiction in
the matter.

In the matter of the Petition }
of William Duncan & others for }
a Road }

The report of the viewers on the
petition of Wm. Duncan and others for a road, laid over from
a former meeting of the Board, was taken up and considered
by the Board. P. H. Cullen and William Duncan being
present agreed to accept the amounts awarded by the
viewers in full compensation for land taken and damages
on account of the locating of said road on their land
and the Board being of the opinion that said amounts
would be a reasonable compensation the said amounts
were awarded to them as follows.

To P. H. Cullen Ten dollars, and to Wm. Duncan twenty
five dollars, and the Board being of the opinion that thirty
dollars would be a reasonable compensation to John
Spencer for land taken and for damages on account of
said road, that amount was awarded to him, and the
Board being of the opinion that thirty dollars would be a
reasonable compensation for land taken and for
damages to John Bare on account of the location of
said road that amount was awarded to him, and
the Board being of the opinion that said road would be
of sufficient utility to justify them in locating and
establishing the said road it was ordered that the prayer
of the petitioners be granted and that the road be located
and established according to the report of the viewers
