Gentlemen

The undersigned petitioners resident
 householders of Palmyra and Willow Springs Townships
 in Douglas County, Kansas would respectfully represent
 that a public road is very much needed along the line
 described below and would respectfully petition your
 Hon Board to have surveyed, located and established a
 County Road, Beginning at the N. W. cor. of Sec. 31, T. 14 S.
 R. 20 E. thence running East along the section line
 between sections 30 and 31 Township and Range aforesaid.

The petition being signed by at least 12 resident home
 holders of the County and being accompanied by a bond
 as required by law the Board appointed F. B. Varnum
 Frank Sturdy and George Cade as viewers to meet with
 the County Surveyor to view and survey said road.

The County Clerk was instructed to issue the necessary noti-
 ces as required by law.
