A Resolution of the Chamber of Commerce of the City of
Lawrence of which the following is a copy, having been
filed in the office of the County Clerk.

To the Honorable Board Commissioners Douglas County Kansas
Gentlemen

At a called meeting of the Chamber of Commerce
Sept. 9 1879 the following resolution was recommended
to your consideration

Whereas The Kansas Pacific R.R. has leased from the
owners the R.R. known as the Carbondale Road, who
propose to repair and operate said road, and
Whereas the lease contemplates the release of the road
from accrued taxes, and

Whereas said road is now and has been idle for
three years past and no taxes collected. Therefore
Resolved That it is the opinion of the Chamber of
Commerce of the City of Lawrence, and we do recommend
the Board of Commissioners, that said accrued taxes
be remitted, on a proper guarantee for the faithful
repair and operation of said R.R. for a term of years

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of
Lawrence having been filed in the office of the County Clerk
of which the following is a copy.

Resolved that upon condition that the proprietors of the
Carbondale Railroad will before the first day of next
month put said road in repair and running order
and in operation with the K. P. Railroad, and thereafter
continue to operate said road in connection with the
