

Lawrence Kansas Wednesday, October 15th 1879
Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment
at the office of the County Clerk

Those were present Commissioners John Deskins
Chairman John Walton and J. C. Walton and County
Clerk B. F. Duggs.

The County Clerk appointed T. J. Stornburgh
as Deputy County Clerk in addition Albert Brooks who
was temporarily absent and Mr. Stornburgh took the
oath of office and the County Clerk being sick and unable
to remain and attend to the duties of the office Mr. T. J.
Stornburgh Deputy County Clerk acted as clerk for the
Board.

In the Matter of the petition of }
Jacob Yeager for a road }

The report of the viewers appointed
at the July session of the Board on the petition of Jacob
Yeager and others for a change in road, was taken up
by the Board and having been publicly read was
considered by the Board.

There being no claims for land taken or for damages on
account of the change in road as asked for, and the Board
being satisfied that the change would be a public convenience

It was ordered, that the prayer of the petitioners be granted
and that the road asked to be vacated, be vacated and
that the road asked to be located, be located and estab-
lished forty (40) feet in width according to the report
of the viewers and the field note and plat of the Surveyor,
and the Clerk was instructed to enter the same on the
road records of the County and issue the necessary orders
for the vacation and opening of the same.

In the Matter of Iron Bridges }
under Contract not Completed }

An appropriation was made
of \$2805.⁶⁴/₁₀₀ to pay for the Bridge being built by the
Columbia Bridge Works across the Wakarusa River at
Eudora and a further appropriation of \$2997.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ to pay for
the Bridge being built by the Mo. Valley Bridge and Iron
Works, over the Wakarusa river at Hutchinsons Crossing, and
the Clerk was instructed to draw orders on the County
Treasurer for the same according to the terms of the
Contracts for said bridges and to issue them to the said
bridge Companies when the Bridges are completed and
