In the matter of Borrowing
 money for Gen. fund 3

Oliver Barber County Treasurer reported that
 the general fund of the County was exhausted and asked for an
 order to borrow \$3000.⁰⁰ to pay balance of bills allowed at
 the October session of the Board

The Board having the matter under consideration the follow-
 ing resolution was introduced and on motion adopted
 Resolved that the County be and he is hereby authorized
 to borrow \$3000.⁰⁰ for sixty days for the purpose of paying
 the remainder of the bills allowed at the October term of
 this Board.

In the matter of Agent for
 Compromising the R.R. Bonds 3

The following Communication was
 received from Charles Robinson, which was read and ordered

To the Hon Board of County Commissioners
 Gentlemen

I hereby tender my
 resignation as agent for Compromising the Rail road County
 bonds. Arrangements through my agency have been
 completed for the Compromise of some \$265 000. of the
 bonds & as soon as the blanks are received the exchange
 can be made, but I learn the people are dissatisfied with
 your action in the matter & I most cheerfully make room
 for more efficient work
