Sidermark taxes in City of Lawrence

The following communication was received from the City Clerk of the City of Lawrence

Office of City Clerk

Lawrence Kansas November 6th 1879

To the Hon Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas Gentlemen

The City Council of the City of Lawrence at its session held Oct. 6th 1879 adopted a resolution that owners or agents of lots against which sidermark taxes were charged on the tax rolls of 1866, and 1867 and which were at the sales of 1867 and 1868 sold to and still remain in the name of Douglas County, be allowed to redeem the same at any time before the 1st day of January A.D. 1880 at the amounts for which they were originally sold so far as the City's interest in said sidermark taxes may appear.

I therefore request your Hon. body to give the necessary orders to the Treasurer to carry the above abatement into effect
