

Lawrence Kansas Monday January 5th 1880
 Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to law
 at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners John Deskins
 Chairman John Walton and J. C. Walton and Deputy
 County Clerk Albert H. Brooks
 In the matter of Appeal from decision }
 of Co. Supt. in regard to division of School }
 Districts No. 5, 28 and 50. }

The Board had under consideration
 the appeal of petitioners for the formation of a new School
 District to be made up from portions of School districts
 No. 5, 28 and 50, from the decision of the County
 Superintendent refusing to form a new district as
 petitioned for.

John Wilder Esq. appeared and delivered an argument
 in favor of sustaining the appeal, and Newton Henshaw
 and several others made arguments, in favor of sustaining
 the decision of the County Superintendent.

After listening to arguments, and a statement by the
 County Superintendent in regard to the matter the Board
 took the case under advisement.

In the matter of Redemption }
 of land in Sec. 24, T. 13, R. 18, by P. Platz }

Philip Platz appeared before the
 Board and made a statement in regard to a certain piece
 of land in Sec. 24, T. 13, R. 18, and offered to pay for the redemp-
 tion of the same from all sales to County. The amount
 for which said land was sold and interest on the same
 at ten percent per annum and costs of redemption and on
 motion it was ordered that Philip Platz be allowed to redeem
 certificate No. 1033 of the sale of 1876 certificate No. 168 of the sale
 of 1878, and certificate No. 180 of the sale of 1879 all of said certificates
 being held by the County, upon the payment by him of the
 amounts of said sales with interest thereon at the rate
 of ten percent per annum and costs of redemption.

Board adjourned until tomorrow morning at
 9 o'clock
