And on motion it was ordered, that the County Treasurer assign the certificates held by the County on said lots upon the payment by him of \$2.00 per lot, and the surrender of all subsequent certificates sold to individuals, the Redemption and assignment certificates to be made without costs.

In the matter of appeal from }
decision of Co. Supt. in regard }
to school districts, No. 5, 28 and 50 }

The Board resumed consideration of the appeal of certain petitioners for the formation of a school district to be made up from portions of school districts No. 5, 28 and 50, from the decision of the County Superintendent refusing to divide said districts, the same having been laid over from yesterday's meeting.

After a full discussion of the matter, the Board came to the conclusion that the grounds for the appeal were not sufficient to justify them in reversing the decision of the County Superintendent and on motion it was ordered that the decision of the County Superintendent refusing to grant the petition for the formation of a new district be sustained.

In the matter of the assessment }
of cattle to W. W. Cockrins }

W. W. Cockrins made a proposition to the Board offering to pay the tax on a valuation of \$1836.00 for a lot of cattle assessed to him in Wakarusa Township, which he states were also assessed in Osage County for that amount and the same cattle were also assessed in Eudora Township in Douglas County. But that the assessment in Wakarusa Township was excessive and the assessment in Eudora Tp. was illegal.

The Board having the matter under consideration and believing there was some doubt as to the legality of the assessment, on motion, it was ordered by the Board, that the proposition of the said W. W. Cockrins be accepted and the clerk be and he is hereby instructed to cancel on the tax rolls of the County the tax on the valuation of all
