whole of the tax on the cattle as assessed in Eudora Township

In the matter of the Petition of
John Staib and others for a road

The report of the viewers appointed at the
July meeting of the board on the petition of John Staib and
others for the location of a road and which was laid over
from the October meeting of the Board was taken up for Consider-
ation. The claim of J. P. Wasson for Damages was
considered, and Mr. Wasson being present agreed to take
forty dollars in full for all damages and land provided the
road was located and established, and the claims of Charles
Gulletty and S. A. Stonebaker were considered, and it was
agreed by the Board that \$30.⁰⁰ each would be a reasonable
compensation for land taken and damages and the Board
agreed to allow to the said J. P. Wasson \$40.⁰⁰ and to Chas.
Gulletty and S. A. Stonebaker \$30.⁰⁰ each provided they would
accept the same in full for all claims for damages on
account of said road and for land taken, and I ordered
that if the said J. P. Wasson, Chas. Gulletty and S. A. Stonebaker
should within 30 days accept the amounts above awarded
that the Report of the viewers be adopted and the Road
located and established according to the field notes and
plat of the Surveyor, and the Clerk be instructed to enter
the same in the Road Records of the County and issue
the necessary orders for opening the same according
