But if the said parties fail to accept the awards as above
It was ordered that the Road be located and established from
the place of beginning, South two miles between sections
32nd and 33 of Township 14, and sections 4th and 5 of Township
15, to the Corner to Secs. 4, 5, 8, and of said Township 15;
and also beginning at the Corner to Secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, of
said Township 15, and thence running South one mile
between sections 16th and 17 to the South line of Douglas
County, there being no claims for damages or objections
to those portions of the road.

The bill of Abby Pickens for rent of room for holding
election November November 4th 1879 in Big Springs was
considered and allowed at \$2.50 and the Clerk was
instructed to draw an order on the County Treasurer for
the same.

Board adjourned until tomorrow morning
at 9 o'clock.
