

for damages and there being no legal objections to the following described portion of the road, viz:

Beginning at the corner of Secs. 13, 14, 23rd and 24th of T. 14 R. 20 and running North $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. between Secs. 1 and 2 it was ordered by the Board that that portion of the road beginning at the corner of Secs. 13, 14, 23rd and 24th Township 14 South of Range 20 E. and running thence North according to the field notes and plat of the Surveyor $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. between sections one and two of said Township and Range, be and the same is hereby located and established as a County road and that the Clerk enter the same in the road records of the County and issue the necessary orders for the opening of the same according to law.

And that portion of the report referring to the balance of the road petitioned for was laid over until Wednesday the 14th day of April at the next April meeting of the Board in the matter of the petition of J. W. Gillaspie for a change of Road 3

The following petition signed by J. W. Gillaspie and others for the vacation and relocation of a certain road was presented to the Board.

To the Hon. the Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co., Kansas
The undersigned voters of LeCompton Township petition your Honorable body to vacate a certain portion of the road leading from Big Springs to the Kansas River, said vacation to commence at a point where said road crosses a small stream N.E. of John W. Gillaspies dwelling house and running diagonally across E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of S. $W\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 36, T. 11, R. 17 and to relocate said road, commencing at the above named point in said road and running East to the East line of S. $W\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 36, T. 11, R. 17 Douglas County thence North to the North East cor. of S. $W\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 36, T. 11, R. 17. and it appearing that the above petition was signed by at least 12 resident householders and being accompanied by the bond required by law, the Board appointed Frank Waller, Wm. Young and Wm. H. Christian as viewers, to meet with the County Surveyor to view and survey said road according to law.

Claims against the County were considered by the board and allowed as follows.
