Said P. J. Rhodes further proposed to purchase the County's interest in Lots 76, 12 to 22 inclusive on Knott Street, Baldwin City for 50 cents per Lot and return all certificates of illegal sales, said certificates to be filed with the County Clerk and cancelled when deed is made. Kendall praying for permission to redeem Lot No. 169 on Tennessee Street, Lawrence from the Tax of 1862, sale of 1863, for amount for which said Lot was sold with 6 per cent. interest, was considered and granted.
