

Lawrence, Kansas April 14th 1880.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners John Heskies Chairman.
John Walton^{and} J. C. Walton^{and} M. Stevens County Clerk.

In the Matter of the Petition of Wm. Siler^{and} others for a Road } The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid Road^{and} no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same,^{and} believing the same to be of public utility, it is ordered: that the Viewers report of views^{and} report^{and} plat of survey be adopted,^{and} that said road be declared located^{and} established as a public highway in accordance therewith; full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record;^{and} the Trustee of Willow Springs Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel, with permission to maintain gates until March 1st 1881. It is further ordered, that a warrant be issued to J. B. Whisler for Twenty Five Dollars (\$25⁰⁰) in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location^{and} establishment of said road.

In the matter of the Petition of A. J. Allen^{and} others for a Road. } A. J. Allen^{and} others petitioners for the location of a road in Palmyra Township appeared to present facts concerning the aforesaid proposed road, but owing to the absence of the parties of the opposition, the hearing of the matter was continued until Tuesday, April 20th 1880, at 10^h o'clock A. M.

In the matter of the Petition of H. J. Davis^{and} others for the vacation } The Petition of H. J. Davis^{and} others for the Location of a Road. } The Petition of H. J. Davis^{and} others for the Vacation^{and} Location of a road in Wacarcusa Township, was granted. Provided the person claiming damages accept Twenty Five Dollars (\$25⁰⁰) on or before Wednesday of the next regular session of the Board. Otherwise the petition to stand rejected.

Examination of accounts against the County was then proceeded with.

Board adjourned to meet April 15th 1880, at 9 o'clock A. M.
