In the matter of the Petition of
John Stuib and others for the
Location of a Road.

The Board of County Commissioners, having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same, and believing it to be of public utility, it was ordered that the Viewers report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record; and the Trustee of Palmyra Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.

It is further ordered that warrants be issued to J. P. Wasson, for \$40.00 to Charles Galletty for \$35.00 and to S. A. Stonebraker for \$35.00, in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road.
