Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners John Beckner Chairman, John Walton^{2nd} J. C. Walton^{2nd} County Clerk. W. D. Stevens.

In the matter of transfer of County's Interest in W¹/₂ Lot 38, Addn 9, N. Lawrence to J. W. Barrough.

The Board having under consideration the proposition of J. W. Barrough it was ordered that the said J. W. Barrough be authorized^{and} empowered to purchase the County's interest in the W¹/₂ of Lot 38, Addn 9, in North Lawrence upon payment to the County of One Dollar and the surrender for cancellation of all illegal certificates outstanding against said property.

In the matter of the petition of R. Sterling for the redemption of Lot 139, R. D. St. Lawrence.

The Board of Commissioners having under consideration the petition of Robert Sterling for the redemption of Lot 139, Rhode Island Street, Lawrence, it was ordered, That the County Treasurer be authorized^{and} directed to allow Robert Sterling to redeem said lot from the sale to the County for the year 1867, from all tax except side walk Special tax at the amount for which the same was sold^{and} interest at the rate of ten per cent. per annum.

In the matter of Furnishing Ice for County officers^{and} jail.

The Board of Commissioners having under consideration Propositions for furnishing Ice for County officers^{and} jail the proposition of Julius Fischer to supply ice for all the County officers^{and} jail for the season of 1880, for Thirty Five Dollars (\$35⁰⁰), was accepted.
