

Lawrence, Kansas, April 26<sup>th</sup> 1880.

Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners John T. Parker, Chairman, John Walton <sup>and</sup> J. C. Walton <sup>and</sup> County Clerk, W. D. Stevens.

In the matter of transfer of County's interest in  $W\frac{1}{2}$  Lot. 38, Addie 9, North Lawrence to J. W. Darrough.

The Board having under consideration the proposition of J. W. Darrough it was ordered that the said J. W. Darrough be authorized <sup>and</sup> empowered to purchase the County's interest in the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot. 38, Addie 9, in North Lawrence upon payment to the County of One Dollar and the surrender for cancellation of all illegal certificate, outstanding against said property.

In the matter of the petition of R. Sterling for the redemption of

Lot. 159, R. I. St. Lawrence. The Board of Commissioners having under consideration the petition of Robert Sterling for the redemption of Lot. 159, Rhode Island Street, Lawrence, it was ordered, That the County Treasurer be authorized <sup>and</sup> directed to allow Robert Sterling to redeem said lot from the sale to the County for the year 1867, from all tax except side walk special tax at the amount for which the same was sold <sup>and</sup> interest at the rate of ten per cent. per annum.

In the matter of furnishing

Ice for County offices <sup>and</sup> jail. The Board of Commissioners having under consideration propositions for furnishing ice for County offices <sup>and</sup> jail the proposition of Julius Fischer to supply ice for all the County offices <sup>and</sup> jail for the season of 1880, for Thirty Five Dollars (\$35.00), was accepted.

In the matter of the petition of

J. M. Tucker to purchase the County's interest in the tax sales

of certain lots in Clinton.

The Board of Commissioners having under consideration the petition of J. M. Tucker for the purchase of the County's interest in certain lots in Clinton, it was ordered,

That the County Treasurer be authorized <sup>and</sup> directed to transfer the County's interest in the following described property, in the Town of Clinton to wit:
