Begin at the S.W. Cor. of Sec. 6, Town 14, Range 19, running thence East on Sec. line to S.E. corner of Sec. 5, Town 14, Range 19.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Joseph Hoover as principal <sup>and</sup> P.A. Bolbee as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, which bond was approved, <sup>and</sup> it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that W. S. Holbut, B. G. Hogue <sup>and</sup> Adam Lynd be appointed Viewers of the said road <sup>and</sup> that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view <sup>and</sup> lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing <sup>and</sup> make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of  
W. F. Myers <sup>and</sup> others for the  
change of a Road.

On the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March 1880, a Road petition was filed signed by W. F. Myers <sup>and</sup> 26 others, praying for the change of a road described as follows:

Begin at a point on the E. line of the S.E. <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 23, Town 14, Range 18, where the road from the north intersects said line thence South on the East line of said <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Sec. to the S.E. cor. of the same, and to vacate that portion of said road that connects the two points above named which runs across the said S.E. <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 23, Town 14, Range 18.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by W. F. Myers, as principal <sup>and</sup> George Orhole <sup>and</sup> Cornelia Ripen as sureties in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, which bond was approved <sup>and</sup> it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that C. M. Fisher, J. E. Myers <sup>and</sup> Levi Myers, be appointed Viewers of the said road <sup>and</sup> that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view <sup>and</sup> lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing <sup>and</sup> make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of  
Mathias Simon <sup>and</sup> others for

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February 1880, a Road petition was filed signed by Mathias Simon <sup>and</sup> 16 others praying for the vacation of a road described as follows:  
Beginning at the S.W. cor. of Sec. 21, Town 14, Range 18, <sup>and</sup> running due East one half mile to intersect road run-
