Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Matthias Simon as principal ^{and} Phillip Rheinschild as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that J. C. Meloxer, W. Postma ^{and} Samuel Miller be appointed Viewers of the said road ^{and} that on the day named in their notice, together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing ^{and} make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
C. P. Roy ^{and} others for the
Location of a Road.

On the 12th day of April 1880, a Road petition was filed signed by C. P. Roy ^{and} 11 others praying for the Location of a road described as follows:

Begin at the S.W. cor. of Sec. 17, Town 15, Range 18. ^{and} terminate at the N.W. cor. of Sec. 5, Town 15, Range 18, said road to run North and South between Secs 5 ^{and} 6, 7 ^{and} 8, 17 ^{and} 18.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by C. P. Roy as principal ^{and} R. S. Dodder ^{and} M. Dodder, as sureties in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that John Keely, Moses McMillan ^{and} H. H. Oliver be appointed Viewers of the said road ^{and} that on the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view ^{and} lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing ^{and} make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
Henry Weaver ^{and} others for the
Location of a Road.

On the 21st day of April 1880, a Road petition was filed, signed by Henry Weaver ^{and} 16 others praying for the Location of a road described as follows:

Beginning about 30 Rods North of the N.E. cor. of Sec. 4, Town 13, Range 21, on Sec. line between Secs 33 ^{and} 34 Town 12, Range 21, thence South westerly along the A. T. ^{and} S. F. R. R. to intersect a County road at or near the Eudora Ferry.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law, signed by Henry Weaver as principal ^{and} A. B. Cohn as surety, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law
