In the matter of the Petition of {

{ On the 12th day of April 1880, a Road Petition was filed signed by O. W. Spencer ^{and} 14 others ^{and} presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a road described as follows:

Beginning at the S.E. corner of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10, T. 12, R. 17. (where the Facer petition turns west) running on the Shawnee County line $\frac{1}{2}$ mile North Thru West on Section line to intersection of Lawrence ^{and} Topeka State Road.

It was ordered by the Board that J. Waller, Wm Young ^{and} Wm Nace be appointed Viewers of said road ^{and} that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view ^{and} lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing ^{and} make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of {
Philip Metsker ^{and} others for the {
Location of a Road.

{ On the 10th day of February 1880, a Road Petition was filed signed by Philip Metsker ^{and} 11 others ^{and} presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a road described as follows:

Commencing at the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section corner on the South line of Section 18, Twp 14, Range 19, ^{and} running thence West on the Section line between Secs 18 ^{and} 19, Town ^{and} range aforesaid to the Range line between Ranges 18 ^{and} 19.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Philip Metsker as principal ^{and} Peter A. Dolbee ^{and} S. W. Metsker as sureties in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved.

Upon due consideration, ^{and} no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the aforesaid road ^{and} believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that said road be declared located ^{and} established according to the prayer of petitioners, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record ^{and} the Trustee of Willow Springs Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the Public travel.
