Location of a Road. { On the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April 1880, a Road Petition was filed signed by O. H. Spencer <sup>and</sup> 14 others <sup>and</sup> presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows:

Beginning at the S.E. corner of the N.E.<sup>1/4</sup> of Sec. 10, T. 12, R. 17. (where the former petition turns west) running on the Shawnee County line  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile north thence West on section line to intersection of Lawrence <sup>and</sup> Sepuka State Road.

It was ordered by the Board that J. Waller, Wm Young <sup>and</sup> Wm Pace be appointed Viewers of said road <sup>and</sup> that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view <sup>and</sup> lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing <sup>and</sup> make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of  
Philip Metzker <sup>and</sup> others for the

Location of a Road. { On the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February 1880, a Road Petition was filed signed by Philip Metzker <sup>and</sup> 11 others <sup>and</sup> presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the location of a road described as follows:

Commencing at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section corner on the South line of Section 18, Town 14, Range 19. <sup>and</sup> running thence West on the Section line between Secs 18 <sup>and</sup> 19, Town <sup>and</sup> range aforesaid to the Range line between Ranges 18 <sup>and</sup> 19.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by Philip Metzker as principal <sup>and</sup> Peter A. Dolbee <sup>and</sup> S. W. Metzker as sureties in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved.

Upon due consideration, <sup>and</sup> no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of the aforesaid road <sup>and</sup> believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that said road be declared located <sup>and</sup> established according to the prayer of petitioners, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record <sup>and</sup> the Trustee of Willow Springs Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel.
