

In the matter of the Petition
of G. L. Wilbur ^{and others} for
the Change of a Road.

On the 21st day of April 1880, a Road
petition was filed signed by G. L. Wilbur ^{and 11 others} and presented to the
Board of Commissioners praying for the Change of a road,
described as follows:

Begin at the S.W. cor. of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 18, Town 13,
Range 21. Thence in a Southwesterly direction about 15 rods, thence West
5 rods thence in a Northwesterly direction to intersection of old road
about 15 rods.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law
signed by G. L. Wilbur as principal ^{and} C. M. Sears ^{and} Thomas
Rayson as sureties in the sum of Fifty Dollars, which bond
was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had
been substantially complied with it was ordered that John
Collier, A. W. Kames ^{and} Daniel Struter be appointed Viewers of
the said road ^{and} that upon the day named in their notice
together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view ^{and}
lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a
hearing ^{and} make due report of their proceedings to
this Board.

In the matter of the Petition
of Isaac Barnhart ^{and others}
for the Location of a Road

On the 19th day of February 1880, a Road
Petition was filed signed by Isaac Barnhart ^{and 40 others} and pre-
sented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location
of a road described as follows:

Begin at the N.E. cor. of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 15, Town 15, Range 18,
thence running West to the County line between Douglas ^{and} Osage
Counties.

Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law
signed by Isaac Barnhart as principal ^{and} J. M. Smith ^{and} J. W.
Barnhart as sureties in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, which
bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law
had been substantially complied with it was ordered that D. H.
Maully, P. A. Kolbee ^{and} J. F. Badsky be appointed Viewers of the
said road ^{and} that upon the day named in their notice
together with the County Surveyor, they proceed to view ^{and}
lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties
a hearing ^{and} make due report of their proceedings
to this Board.
