

In the matter of the Petition
of J. G. Schuebley ^{and others} for Bridges
over West Ottawa Creek.

A Petition signed by J. G. Schuebley and
others praying for an appropriation to build a bridge over West
Ottawa Creek at Sutton Crossing ^{and} one over West Ottawa Creek at Ingle
Crossing, was considered by the Board of Commissioners ^{and} it
was ordered, that appropriations be made as follows: For a Bridge
at Sutton Crossing, One Hundred ^{and} Fifty Dollars (\$150⁰⁰) ^{and} for a
Bridge at Ingle Crossing, One Hundred ^{and} Twenty Five Dollars
(\$125⁰⁰). It was further ordered by the Board that the pe-
titioners for the said Bridges be permitted to use any timbers
belonging to the County that may be required in the construction
of the Bridges prayed for.

The following resolution was read ^{and} adopted by the Board:
Resolved, That the County Clerk ^{and} Chairman of the Board
of County Commissioners be authorized ^{and} instructed to issue scrip
to the amount of Eight Thousand Five Hundred ^{and} Ninety Dollars
(\$8,590⁰⁰) to the Missouri Valley Bridge ^{and} Iron Works, when the
Bridge over the Kansas River at Lawrence shall have been tested
^{and} accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

In the matter of the Redemption of
Certain property in Bloomington
assigned to J. C. Steele (now deceased).

The Board of County Commissioners
having under consideration the petition of L. S. Steele for the
