Ewing be authorized to redeem Lot No. 7, in Block 8, Lane's 1st Addition to the City of Lawrence, from sale for taxes of 1874 sale of 1875 with taxes of 1875 and 1877 charged up, for amount for which said Lot was originally sold and 12% interest and costs of redemption.
