

That the Viewers report ^{and view} ^{and report} ^{and plat of survey} be adopted, ^{and} that said road be declared located ^{and} established in accordance therewith; full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record; ^{and} the Trustee of Marion Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public use.

It is further ordered that a warrant be issued to F. M. Jenkins for Ninety Seven Dollars (\$97.00) in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location ^{and} establishment of said road.
