There were present Commissioners John Deacon, Chairman, John Walton ^{and} J. C. Walton ^{and} County Clerk, W. Stevens.

In the matter of the Petition of
Alvin Roberts ^{regarding} for the location
of a road.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid road ^{and} believing it to be of no public utility, it was ordered that the road be rejected.

In the matter of the Petition of
A. F. Allen ^{regarding} for the location
of a road.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the Deacon report and view and report and plot of survey be adopted and that said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith full accord thereto to be made in the County road record and the Trustee of Pottawatomie Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel. Provided. That A. F. Allen or others pay to the County Fifty Dollars. It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue scrip to Abraham Persing to the amount of One Hundred ^{and} Fifty Dollars. (Provided that A. F. Allen or others pay to the County the sum as provided above.) in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location ^{and} establishment of said road.

Board adjourned to meet October 9th 1880, at 9 o'clock A.M.
