Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment at the office of the County Clerk.

There were present Commissioners John Deschamps, Chairman, John Walton and J. C. Walton and County Clerk McJannet.

In the matter of the Petition of
 Allen Roberts and others for the location
 of a road.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid road and believing it to be of no public utility it was ordered that the road be rejected.

In the matter of the Petition of
 A. F. Allen and others for the location
 of a road.

The Board of County Commissioners having under consideration the aforesaid road and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of the same and believing it to be of public utility it was ordered that the survey report and view and report and plat of survey be adopted and that said road be declared located and established in accordance therewith and record thereof to be made in the County road record and the Trustee of Polk Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public use. Provided, That A. F. Allen or others pay to the County Fifty Dollars. It was further ordered that the County Clerk be instructed to issue scrip to Abraham Reising to the amount of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars. (Provided That A. F. Allen or others pay to the County the sum as provided above.) in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road.

Board adjourned to meet October 9th 1880, at 9 o'clock A.M.
