Said Petition was accompanied with bond as required by Law signed by A. H. Buck as principal ^{and} Wm Shaw as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved and it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that Wm Hacer, Frank Walter ^{and} Wm Ingersoll be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view ^{and} lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

Location of a private road.

On the 5th day of October 1880, a Road petition was filed ^{and} presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a Private road as follows: Commencing at a point in Whitfield Street north of a certain Graceland in the City of Decatur about 35 ft N. of said street. Thence running West to the West boundary of said Graceland Thence S. to the Center of Sixth Street in said City of Decatur. Thence W. in the center of said 6th Street to the W. boundary line of said City of Decatur. Said Petition was accompanied with bond as required by Law signed by A. A. Sellers as principal ^{and} Oliver Barber as surety in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that J. D. Cunningham, P. A. Todd ^{and} J. K. Nitzel be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view ^{and} lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
