

In the matter of the Petition of
G. W. Cox ^{and} others for the Location
of a road.

On the 3rd day of August 1880, a road petition was filed ^{and} presented to the Board of Commissioners signed by G. W. Cox ^{and} 38 others praying for the location of a County road described as follows: Beginning at S.W. corner of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, Town 14, Range 18, Thence North to the N.W. cor of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, T. 14, R. 18. Said Petition was accompanied with bond as required by Law signed by G. W. Cox as Principal ^{and} Henry Hoover ^{and} Wesley Story as sureties in the sum of One Hundred Dollars which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that Henry Hoover, John Matson ^{and} S. A. Walderman be appointed Viewers of said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing ^{and} make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
Geo Bahnmair ^{and} others for the
Change of a Road.

On the 24th day of September 1880, a Road Petition was filed signed by George Bahnmair and 14 others and presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the change of a county road as follows: To change ^{and} locate on the East line of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 18, T. 12, R. 18, the County road which now runs angling along said East line. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by law signed by George Bahnmair as principal ^{and} J. Buchmair as surety in the sum of Fifty Dollars which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that A. H. Buck, J. C. Vincent ^{and} J. J. Jones be appointed Viewers of said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view ^{and} lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing ^{and} make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
Charles Pilla ^{and} others for the
Location of a Road.

On the 7th day of October 1880, a Road Petition was filed signed by Charles Pilla ^{and} 13 others ^{and} presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a County road described as follows: Beginning at the quarter corner on the East side of Sec. 20, T. 13, R. 21, East, Thence West on the quarter section line 40 chains to the center of section 20 aforesaid. Said Petition was accompanied with bond as required by Law signed by Charles Pilla as Principal
