of Victor Henson ^{and} others for
the Location of a Road.

On the 11th day of October 1880 a road petition was filed signed by Victor Henson ^{and} 41 others ^{and} presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a County Road as follows: Commencing at the North East corner of the North East 1/4 of Sec. 18, T. 15, R. 21, Thence Running West on section line three miles to the North West corner of the North West quarter of Section 14, T. 15, R. 20.

Said Petition was accompanied with bond as required by Law signed by Victor Henson as principal ^{and} John H. Can ^{and} Pat Fenoughly as sureties in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that Fred P. Vaughan, D. C. Barwickson ^{and} J. Davis Semmonds be appointed Viewers of the said Road ^{and} that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view ^{and} lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing ^{and} make due report of their proceedings to this Board.

In the matter of the Petition of
J. J. Slane ^{and} others for the Lo-
cation of a County Road.

On the 30th day of Sept. 1880, a road petition was filed signed by J. J. Slane ^{and} 21 others ^{and} presented to the Board of Commissioners praying for the Location of a County Road as follows: Beginning at the 1/4 Sec corner on the West line of Sec. 29, 14, 20, thence East to intersection of Santa Fe road. Road to be located on North side of 1/2 Sec. line. Said petition was accompanied with bond as required by Law, signed by J. J. Slane as principal and J. B. Redwell as surety in the sum of Fifty Dollars, which bond was approved ^{and} it appearing to the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that J. H. Boine, A. F. Allen ^{and} James Wemans be appointed Viewers of the said road and that upon the day named in their notice together with the County Surveyor they proceed to view ^{and} lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to this Board.
